

Pets: Pets are only allowed in the family parking areas. (Exception-Pet Parade) Your pets must be leashed when outside your motorhomes. *Please cleanup after your pets.*

Pet Parade: There will be a Pet Parade Wednesday at 1:30 pm to 2:30 pm in the Fair petting zoo area east of the General Exhibits Building. You may register your pet(s) at the Information Booth from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm Tuesday and Wednesday from 8:00 am until noon.

Propane: Propane will not be available on the grounds.

Quiet Hours: Quiet hours are from 11:00 pm to 7:00 am. Generator operation may only occur in the specific designated parking area.

Red Hat Luncheon: Ladies who did not pre-register for the Red Hat Luncheon may register on site in the Agriculture Building from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm both Tuesday and Wednesday.

Safety: We take Safety Seriously!! Please report any problems to Security. Help us by obeying our rules for you during your stay. We are concerned for the safety of all our members, especially YOU.

Sales Receipts: Please accumulate your sales receipts, complete an expense log that has been provided in your packet and return the log to the box at the Information tables. These are used to document the economic impact of the Six-State Rally within the local community and the State of Louisiana.

Security: There will be roving security during the nighttime hours. However, it is strongly recommended that you do not leave anything out if you are not at your coach and always lock your coach and car. Make sure mobility carts and golf carts are secured when not in use. We can all help if each of us watches for people who do not belong to our group. Most of us know who does not belong. Report suspicious people to our security or call 911 if you see a crime in progress.

Seminar Location: See your Program Book for the seminar specific locations. All changes will be listed in the Daily Newsletter.

Trams: Beginning Tuesday noon, trams will operate from 6:30 am until 5:00 pm. On Thursday, Friday and Saturday tram service will begin at 6:30 and continue until 30 minutes following the conclusion of entertainment each evening. Trams will only stop at the 10 designated tram stops.

Trash: Place all trash in the containers provided.

Vehicle Traffic: *Personal automobiles should not be used for transportation within the grounds.* Golf carts, bicycles, scooters, and mini bikes must use caution and drive slowly. *Pedestrians have the right-of-way.* Only handicap mobility units are allowed in the buildings.

Water: Water is available. Ask parking or security crew for location.

GENERAL RALLY INFORMATION

The following information is provided to make your stay and participation in the rally more enjoyable. Please take time to review the following items and the information on the FAQ sheet in your goodie bag.

Auto ID Hanger: Place the "Auto Hanger" on the back of the rearview mirror of the towed vehicle. The Auto Hanger must be displayed to provide recognition by our security personnel.

Coach Windshield Placard: The Coach Windshield Placard is to be displayed in the lower center of the passenger's side of the motorhome windshield. For reference write your location on the placard and return it to its location in the coach windshield. ***The Placard must be visible at all times.***

Concession Locations: There will be food concessions open Wednesday through Saturday in the Agriculture Building and in Hirsch Coliseum. Concession hours in the Agriculture Building are 10:00 am until 2:00 pm and in the coliseum 10:00 am until closing of entertainment.

Door Prizes: Drawings will occur throughout the rally. Daily drawings will be posted at the SRA Prize Booth in the Exhibitor Area. Cash awards and the Grand Prize cash award will be drawn at the conclusion of Saturday evening's entertainment. You must be present to win.

Emergency Services: First Aid will be provided by local emergency 911 services. Should you need emergency services call 911. State the nature of your emergency and specific location so they can assist in getting local services to you. If in your motorhome, turn on your headlights to help identify your location.

50/50: There will be a 50/50 drawing conducted Thursday and Saturday following the evening's entertainment. Tickets will be sold at the Door Prize booth in the exhibit area and in the Hirsch Coliseum lobby prior to the evening entertainment. The Shriners Hospital for Children in Shreveport has been designated as this year's local charity.

Food: Three breakfasts are included with your registration. They are being served Thursday, Friday, and Saturday mornings in the General Exhibits Building from 7:00 am to 8:30 am. Meal tickets are included in your registration packet and must be presented for service at the specific event. An Ice Cream Social is scheduled for 2:30 pm Thursday.

Honey Wagon: If you need your holding tanks dumped during your stay you may order and pay for the service at the Information Booth located inside the Agriculture Building. The cost will be \$20.00. ***Gray Water is not to be dumped on the grounds.***

Information: The Information Booth will be in the Agriculture Building (Exhibit Area). The hours of operation are 8:00 am to 4:30 pm Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, 9:00 am to 4:30 pm Thursday and Friday, and 9:00 am to noon on Saturday.

Locator Card: The locator card provided in your packet should be completed and turned in at the Information Booth. Your site information will help locate you in case of an emergency and can assist friends in finding you.

Lost and Found: Check at the Information Booth for lost items. All items found should be turned in to Information in the Agriculture Building.

Name Badges: Please wear your badge both on and off the grounds. Your Badge is your admittance to all rally activities.
